Joined BRNC Dartmouth, Sept. 1963, Royal Navy as a career executive officer, specializing as a Naval Aviator (fixed & rotary wing*) and served in the Far East, Singapore, Borneo and the South Atlantic. * Served in the 845, 848, 829, 801 Naval Air Squadrons. He retired from the Royal Navy at his own request in 1978.

Joined the Barclays Group and in 1978 came to Italy as assistant to the Mng. Dir of Banca Barclays Castellini S.p.A, Milan and was responsible for creating Group companies in the areas of factoring, consumer finance and investment banking. In 1981 he transferred to Rome to establish the local branch of the office. In 1986 he returned to London and joined the newly formed investment bank of the Group - Barclays de Zoete Wedd, where he was responsible for the area of export & project finance. In 1992 he was appointed Barclays Group Country Mgr., Italy and Legal Representative; responsible for developing the Bank's business in Italy which then included a Retail Bank network of 200 branches with a balance sheet of € 23 bn, Wealth (Private Banking) and Asset Management, Investment and Corporate Banking employing over 1300 staff throughout Italy, with particular emphasis on the compliance and governance of the Barclays Group Companies which he chaired.
